POLICE DEPARTMENT

Harvest season is upon us. Please be on the lookout for slow moving farm equipment. As careful and alert driving is always required, be especially careful in School Zones and Bus Stops. Children do not always pay attention before they cross the street or sometimes stand just a little too close to the roadway while waiting for a ride. With shorter days comes inclement weather, always give yourself extra travel time to get to your destination. Being in a hurry in poor weather conditions is not worth the risk of an accident. In case of an accident, it is always a good idea to keep an emergency kit in your vehicle. In addition to a first aid kit, water, warning lights and blankets may come in handy. Also keep in mind an old deactivated cell phone can still be used to call 911 in case of an emergency. Just make sure to remember a car charger.

As we get closer to **Christmas**, we as parents begin to look for places to hide gifts from our children, such as in our vehicles. The Wright City Police Department annually takes reports of thieves targeting Christmas gifts stored in vehicles. It starts by a thief searching for unlocked vehicles. Once they gain access, they steal everything. It is recommended to remove anything valuable from your vehicle and make sure your home and vehicle(s) are secure. Report suspicious activity right away, never approach. Law Enforcement is trained and prepared to handle these situations.
