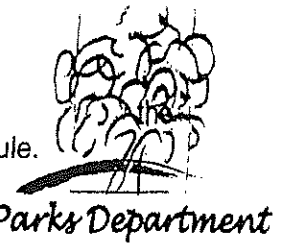


General Info

- There will be two game start times: Between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm. In the event of a tie, next game will start immediately after the completion of the game affected by the tie breaker rule.
- Games being played that are T Ball and Coach Pitch will be 1 hour. Machine Pitch and 8U and 10U will be 1 hour and 30 minutes. All other games will be 1 hour and 45 minutes.



Sportsmanship/Code of Ethics

- **No Tobacco or Alcohol is allowed on the field, in the dugout or within the vicinity (at the Field Managers discretion) of the dugout.**
- All players, managers, coaches, parents and fans whose conduct is unbecoming or offensive, will at a minimum be warned and may be removed from the playing field or stands, without warning, at the discretion of the Umpire, Field Manager or Recreation Director. All players, managers, coaches, parents and fans will be expected to behave in a sportsman like manner. Foul or abusive language of any kind will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- Managers, coaches, assistants, parents and fans must abide by the standards set forth by rules and amendments of the New Horizon Youth Sports League during games, practices and all team functions.
- Physical attack, threatening, fighting, abusive tactics, derogatory or unbecoming acts, destruction of property, verbal assault, use of an illegal player, harassment, bribing, harm, hurt, scare, badgering, stealing property, and other unethical acts that affect the Umpire, Field Manager, Recreation Director, Recreation Department. Representative, managers, coaches, sponsors or player during a game or immediately following the completion of a game played under the administration of the Recreation Departments will result in disciplinary action as determined by the Recreation Director.

Parental Responsibility

- Parents must keep in mind that the Wright City Parks Department offers a recreational league.
- Parents must recognize their commitment to their child and their child's team. Punctuality is necessary for practices and games. Arrangements should be made for the child to wear a clean, complete uniform during the games. It is the parents responsibility to keep track of their child's equipment. It is the parents responsibility to notify coaches if their child is not going attend practices or games.
- Coaches are not to provide daycare services during practices or games. Parents shall be responsible for their child during practices and games. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from games, practices, and team functions.
- Parents shall make an effort to contribute to the team, when assigned to do so.
- Parents are encouraged to support the team coach in discipline, morals, ethics, sportsmanship, and respect.
- It is the parents responsibility to pay for any loss of property due to theft or damages to property caused by their child.

Rainout Policy/Rescheduling of Games

- It will be at the discretion of the Wright City Parks Department and the New Horizon Youth Sports League to reschedule games and tournaments. The Wright City Parks Department and the New Horizon Youth Sports League will determine the dates for the make-up games. Any team that does not make arrangements to play the make-up game will forfeit that game.
