Re: Status of 2020 Season

We would like to thank all families within our program for their understanding and flexibility as we assess the best way to handle our upcoming season amidst the growing concerns associated with the COVID-19 virus. On Wednesday, March 25th, 2020, the League Directors discussed our options moving forward. The plans below have been put into place. Please note that all plans are subject to change based on the continued recommendations of local health officials and community leaders.

- “Opening Day” has been postponed from April 20th to May 4th.
- All teams should be prepared to play games through the end of July
 - All teams should be prepared to play games on Friday’s
 - The schedule is projected to be released on April 13th
- 7U & 8U teams will be scheduled 8 games to meet game minimum
- 9U & Up will be scheduled 10 games to meet game minimum

We once again emphasize that all plans will be continually reassessed as new information becomes available regarding the active health crisis. If and when modifications are made, we will release them to you as soon as practical. All organizations within New Horizon remain unconditionally committed to player safety. It is our sincere hope that conditions will allow us to begin a successful 2020 season very soon.
