

The City of Wright City suspends spring youth sports activities.

Keeping the health and well-being of all Wright City players, coaches, families, and others involved in the spring youth sports programs a priority, and to limit potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus, Wright City Park's activities have been suspended through March 29, 2020. This includes all games and practices. At this point, we do not anticipate the delay affecting baseball, softball, and t-ball opening day as it is scheduled for April 13, 2020. Spring youth soccer will delay its start time to April 11th, 2020. We are also canceling the Battle Blast that was scheduled for March 28th. This policy goes into effect as of today, March 16th, 2020. We will continue to work with the Warren County Health Department and recommendations from the state of Missouri regarding the COVID-19 virus and group activities.

Wright City will be evaluating conditions to determine when it will be appropriate to reinstate practices and will update accordingly.
