## **New Business**

New Horizon Youth League Status – The Board and Mr. Cole expressed their concerns regarding COVID-19 and participating in the New Horizon Youth Baseball League for the summer. Mr. Cole does not want the liability of having coaches, parents, and players responsible to wipe down the facilities after use. Mr. Cole added that logistically the City could not handle having the season. With the low number of staff to umpire games and help disinfect the facilities before and after each game, the City could not do their due diligence to create a safe recreational facility and ball league. After discussion, Alderman Rohr moved and Alderman Dixon seconded the motion to cancel Wright City's participation in the New Horizon Youth Baseball League for summer 2020. On voice vote, the motion was approved 4-0.

Rights-of-Way Application and permit fee – Mr. Schuchmann presented a Rights-of-Way Agreement Application Form for the construction, maintenance, and use of communication or related facilities in the City's Rights-of-way. The deposit amount will be \$500.00 which shall be utilized to offset City costs in the process. Any amount not used will be refunded to the applicant after execution of the agreement.
