MoDOT Listening Session I-70

With approval to expand I-70, the Missouri Department of Transportation has begun a study to re-evaluate the findings of the Interstate 70 Environmental Study from the mid-2000s. The study includes reviewing a 36-mile portion of the I-70 corridor from just west of Route 19 (Milepost 174) to Wentzville Parkway (Milepost 208) in Montgomery, Warren, and St. Charles Counties.

One of the first steps the team is taking is to hold Listening Sessions with stakeholders to understand the changes that have taken place in the communities along the corridor since 2006. This is a chance for stakeholders to give comments regarding any concerns or thoughts for improvements along the corridor. During the Listening Session, MoDOT looked for candidates to participate in their Community Advisory Groups (CAGs). These groups will meet two or three times during the project, to provide guidance and community input as alternatives for improving I-70 are considered within the region.

Adjournment
