

**City of Wright City
Special Board of Aldermen Meeting
Wednesday, May 19, 2021
City Hall, 636 Westwoods Road**

Mayor Dan Rowden called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Board of Aldermen Chambers of the City Hall, 636 Westwoods Road, Wright City, Missouri.

Roll Call

Ms. Ogborn called roll with Alderman Rohr, Alderman Heiliger, Alderman Hakim, Alderman Andrews and Mayor Rowden were present. City Staff present were City Attorney Paul Rost via Zoom, City Administrator Jim Schuchmann and City Clerk Abbie Ogborn.

Mr. Schuchmann informed the Board of 2017 Dodge Charger was available from the Missouri State Highway Patrol in the amount of \$16,950.00 that would replace the K9 car that had been totaled and asked the Board if this classified as an emergency purchase. The Board was in agreeance to send Officer Filson, who has previous mechanic knowledge, to go inspect the car and report back to the Board before approving to purchase.

Vote to Enter Executive Session

Alderman Rohr moved and Alderman Andrews seconded the motion to enter Executive Session to discuss matters pursuant to Section 610.021 (12), RSMo; Legal actions, causes of action, litigation or privileged communications between the City's representatives and its attorney. A roll call vote was taken, Alderman Don Andrews - Yea, Alderman Nathan Rohr - Yea, Alderman Michelle Heiliger – Yea, Alderman Ramiz Hakim – Yea. On voice vote, the motion was approved 4-0.

Vote to Exit Executive Session

Alderman Heiliger moved and Alderman Rohr seconded the motion to exit Executive Session and return to regular session. A roll call vote was taken, Alderman Nathan Rohr - Yea, Alderman Don Andrews - Yea, Alderman Ramiz Hakim – Yea, Alderman Michelle Heiliger – Yea. On voice vote, the motion was approved 4-0.

Alderman Heiliger stated she is attending a MML conference in June and invited the Board.

Adjournment

Alderman Heiliger moved and Alderman Hakim seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. On voice vote, the motion was approved 4-0.

Alderman Heiliger withdrew her motion and Alderman hakim withdrew his second to adjourn the meeting.

Discussion was held regarding the pressing need to fill the Building Inspector / Code Enforcement Officer Position. The Board discussed that it could not wait until the next meeting. Mr. Schuchmann recommended the Board of Aldermen hire Neil Fick at \$57,000 per year. Alderman Andrews moved and Alderman Rohr seconded the motion to extend an offer for the Building Inspector / Code Enforcement

Officer position at a salary of \$57,000.00 to Neil Fick with a 6-month probation period along with a 30-day and 60-day review.

Alderman Heiliger moved and Alderman Hakim seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. On voice vote, the motion was approved 4-0.
