The Wright City Police Department is conducting a hiring process for Police Officers. Qualified applicants will be contacted and scheduled for standardized Personnel Evaluation Profile (PEP) testing in the near future.

BENEFITS:

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- High school diploma or equivalent required
- Police Academy graduate or Missouri Peace Officer Certification (POST) required
- Valid driver's license
- Must be at least 21 years of age

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS and ABILITIES:

- Maintain continuing education hours annually as required by the Missouri POST Commission
- Ability to use good judgment and think quickly in difficult or stressful situations
- Ability to identify potential liabilities and minimize negative exposure

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Protect citizens by preventing crime, enforcing laws, apprehending suspects, and monitoring traffic
- Prevents crime by explaining and enforcing applicable federal, state, local laws and ordinances

- Fulfills court orders by serving warrants and commitments
