#### **Reports**

**Parks** – The Flag Retirement Ceremony will be June 15<sup>th</sup>, the Nature Walk at Ruge Park will be June 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Summer Splash will be July 13<sup>th</sup>.

**Public Works** – The department continues to replace slabs on Freedom Lane. The department has received many thanks for the work they continue to do city wide.

**Building Official** – Public Water District #2 will be conducting smoke tests towards the end of June into July. A 12-acre parcel in the industrial park (lots 4 & 5) has sold and a 30,000 square foot building will be built to accommodate future renters. Myers Select homes will be installing 7" concrete streets in future phases of The Shire. Cuivre River has donated \$1,000.00 for the 62-acre park.

**Police** – Lieutenant Sutton thanked Public Works for redoing the landscaping at the Police Department. Lieutenant provided 6-month statistics of the department's productivity.

City Hall – Ms. Ogborn is moving forward with requests from NOC. On June 20<sup>th</sup>, the National Night Out committee is hosting a dine-to-donate at Texas Roadhouse to raise funds for the event on August 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Treasurer** – Ms. Hutchings is continuing to work on the audit and a draft will be presented at the June 27<sup>th</sup> meeting. Preparations for the 6-month financial is underway.
